



MISS BLEASE FROM BELIZE

THE CARIBBEAN'S HOTTEST DJ IN HEELS

Over the past 8 years, **Linda Blease** (aka Miss Blease) has emerged as a top radio disc jock and an eccentric, sociable media personality active throughout the Caribbean.

Many International Reggae, Dancehall and Soca artists already know Miss Blease as a powerful Belizean media influence. Her TV and radio shows are a must for any visiting entertainer. This promising **DJ Queen of the Caribbean** has been directly credited for giving many newer Caribbean acts a Belizean 'buss' and has a strong, ongoing connection with the entertainment fraternity in Jamaica and the USA.

On some days at home, this **fast-moving** Belizean young lady rocks the airwaves on TV and radio. She hosts two popular radio shows and produces her own TV show, the top TV show for youth audiences in Belize – **Spotlight MVS**. On weekends, Miss Blease rules the clubs and parties as a top-billed turntable specialist with a reputation for getting the **hottest women** to 'gwan bad' in any party, with multiple genres.

Linda has delivered music in every nook and



cranny of Belize. Internationally, she has been a guest on events in **Los Angeles, New York,** and **South Florida**.

In February 2012, Miss Blease performed for the first time in **Jamaica** as a guest DJ in Quad night club, in what may now be described as a major strategic breakthrough.

Miss Blease from Belize has since appeared at least twice in almost every major nightclub in Kingston Jamaica, to include Fiction, Quad, Privilege nightclubs. She has performed at several popular restaurants and lounges such as **Macau** and **Usain Bolt's Tracks & Records**, as well as two performances at the posh **Blue Beat Lounge** in Montego Bay.

In July 2012, Miss Blease was featured as a part of the greatest reggae show on earth. In fact, Blease appeared on Reggae Sumfest 2012's Beach Party as the **only Queen** among five of the reggae industry's top Disc Jock **Kings**.

Within days of an excellent Reggae Sumfest performance, Blease flew across to the Eastern Caribbean to the twin-island republic of Trinidad & Tobago, delivering two smashing nights at the popular **Woodford Cafe** in Port-of-Spain.

With a new Jamaican-based business link adding resources and working to extend her existing track record, Miss Blease from Belize is enthusiastically expanding her name and her brand as a **premium** Caribbean Disc Jock.

In addition to a return to Port of Spain in the near future, fans can look forward to her debut appearances in Barbados & Antigua later this year.

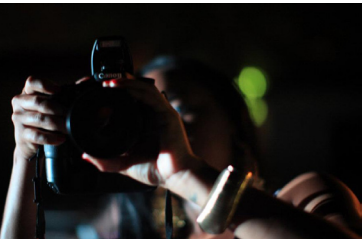
THE HISTORY OF LINDA BLEASE

Linda Michelle Blease was born on December 29, 1986, in Belize City and raised on the Island known as Caye Caulker - a 3 street island off the coast of Belize. Like most Caribbean women, she rose from humble beginnings, in an environment with few privileges. **Pride** and a **pure craving** for opportunity carried her through a childhood filled with a mix of extreme hardships and rich blessings.

Her first sojourn into music was in **Church**. She sang in her church choir and learned to play instruments and even played the keyboard in the church band.

Life Challenges

Past her mid teens, Linda encountered her most difficult battles as a young adult. At times she had no immediate support system and no place to call home. She kept pushing forward even as she moved to Belize City to attend college. While there she began performing in local stage plays and subsequently got a chance to work at a local Radio Station, **KREM TV** in 2004 (at just 17 years of age). Teaming with the manager at KREM, she grasped an opportunity to write a youth column in local news paper - 'Spotlight'. The column became hit.



At the age of 22, she evolved that newspaper article into the **Spotlight Music**

Video Show – the first legitimate, high quality music video show in Belize on Krem TV.

With an innovative approach to producing her radio and TV shows, her media influence grew throughout the Belize community at home and abroad – both on and off the air. She has made guest appearances on numerous Caribbean community events in Los Angeles, Miami, and New York.

Caribbean Role Model

Linda is very active in social outreach programs and hopes to do a media production camp for inner-city Caribbean youths. She often takes time to talk to other young women facing challenges, sharing stunning bits and pieces of her own realities growing up in Belize. She reminds young people just

how important it is to persevere, always having the right attitude. She encourages them to be fearlessly innovative.

In 2011, She was named the official DJ for September Celebrations in Belize. In 2012, Linda was named the official DJ of the annual **Women in Arts Festival** in Belize.

Caribbean Breakthrough

Early in 2012, during a 2-week visit to a fellow Belizean and best friend living in Jamaica, she was invited to perform as a **guest DJ** at **FIV3** – A Friday night event at the Quad Night Club in Kingston, Jamaica.



That first unexpected gig, has led to a worldwind of opportunities. It has opened new doors for her all across the caribbean, from Negril to Port-of-spain Trinidad and beyond.

She also found alignment with a new team of people who share a vision for her. She stands

tall for the women of the Caribbean and is currently marketed and recognized as **The Caribbean's Hottest DJ in Heels**.

Career & Focus

She's focussed on and passionate about her career as a **Disc Jock**, even as she remains equally skilled as a photographer, director, producer, socialite, promoter, and videographer. She looks forward to a particularly sunny caribbean future. :-)
